- Do not operate in ambient temperatures above those indicated on the luminaire nameplate.

To avoid Fire:

- Keep flammable and combustible materials away from the light source and/or lens.
- Ensure lamps are installed correctly.
- Use correctly rated supply conductors as indicated by product labeling.

Burn:

- Allow luminaire and lamps to cool before handling luminaire or changing lamp.
- Follow all warnings, restrictions and recommendations given by the lamp manufacturers.

Personal Injury:

- Wear safety glasses and gloves when handling the luminaire to avoid physical injury.
- Avoid direct eye contact with light source.
- Always support the weight of the luminaire.
